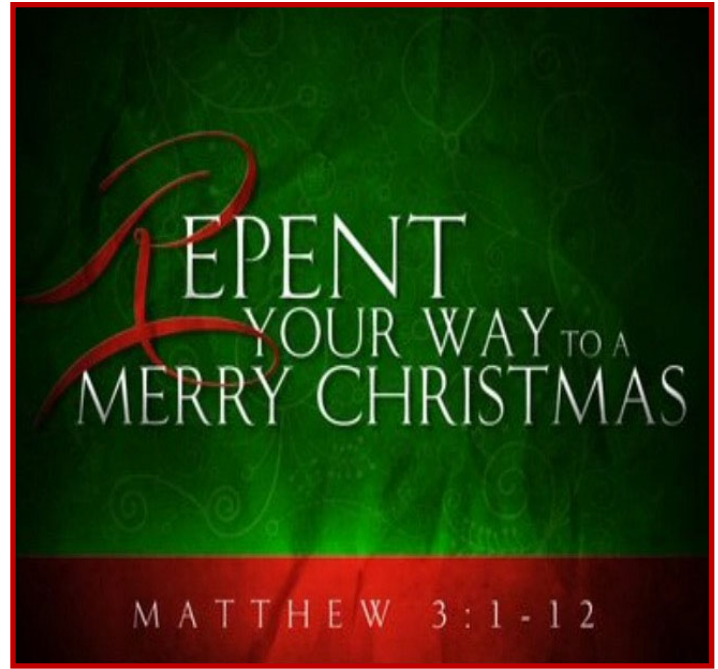

*I wish to thank our parish community for the outpouring of prayers and condolences on the passing of my sister. Diane was known to many of you as she was a member here from 2012-2015.*


