Are we grateful for the wonderful miracle of hearing or do we take it for granted? And are we Listening? By definition listening is to pay attention to a sound that is received through the ears and the brain converts these sounds to a meaningful message to us. Listening requires focus and thoughtful attention and giving consideration. It is the first skill in language. The others are Speaking, Reading and Writing. In pregnancy, the sense of touch is the first to develop at 3 weeks gestation. By 16 weeks gestational age, a baby's ears are formed. At 20 weeks the nerves are intact allowing a baby to listen in the womb. Your baby hears amniotic fluid movement and the sound of circulation from the mother's heartbeat. Hearing is the last sense that ceases when one dies, so make your words count. The word **Hear** is used over 330 times and the word **Listen** is used over 300 times in the bible. The word **Heard** is first used in Genesis 3:8 after the fall of Adam and Eve. The Gospels of St. Matthew, St. Mark and St. Luke state that from a cloud came a voice that said "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased: listen to Him." God has given us ample opportunities and means hear and listen. Lent is a perfect time to focus on our relationship with God and Listen.
