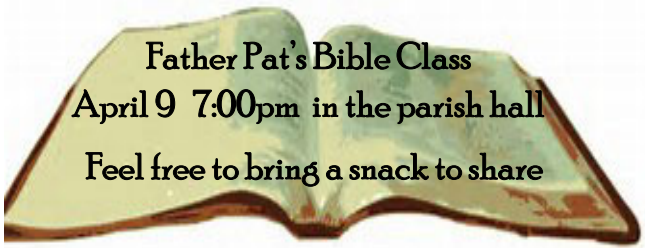

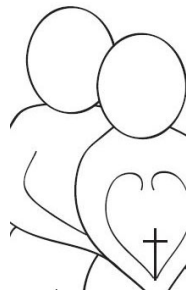

## Facts about High Blood Pressure

**1. High blood pressure may be linked to dementia.** Uncontrolled high blood pressure during midlife (age 45 to 65) creates a higher risk for dementia later in life. **Mind Your Risks**, a campaign from the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke, is educating people about the importance of controlling high blood pressure in midlife.

**2. Young people can have high blood pressure, too.** The increased risk for stroke among young adults is a direct result of the rising rates of obesity, high blood pressure, and diabetes-conditions that are preventable and treatable. Many people with high blood pressure don't even know they have it. The only way to know is to check your blood pressure regularly.

**3. High blood pressure usually doesn't have any symptoms**
